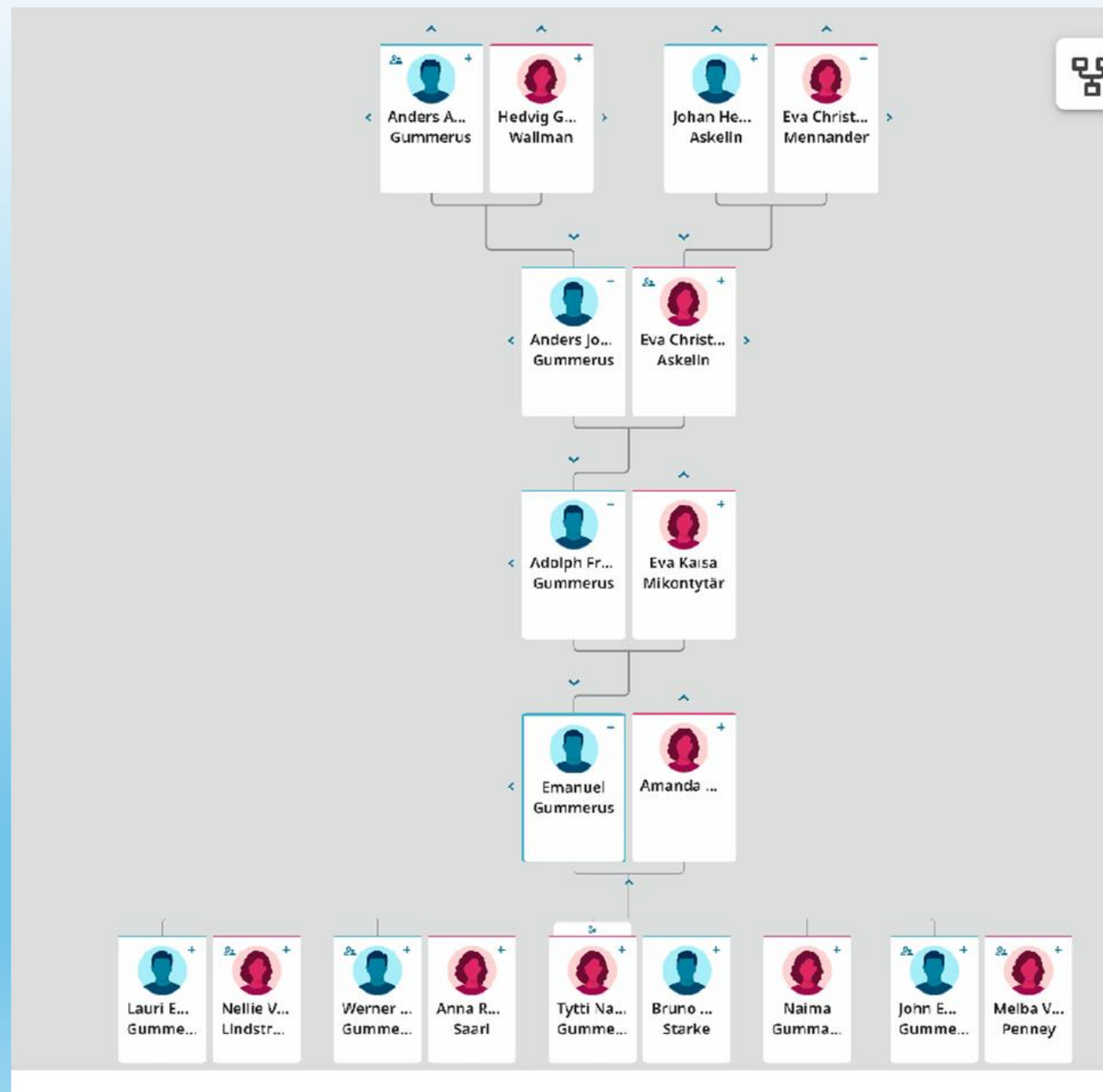


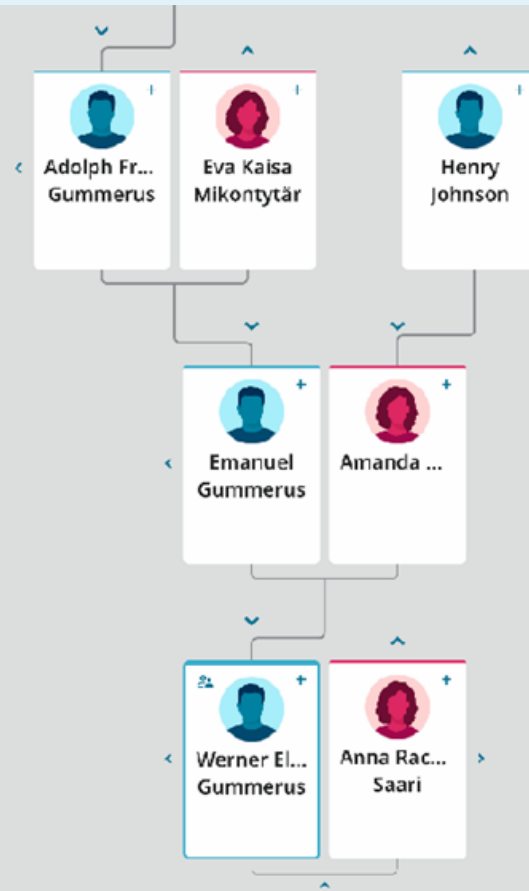

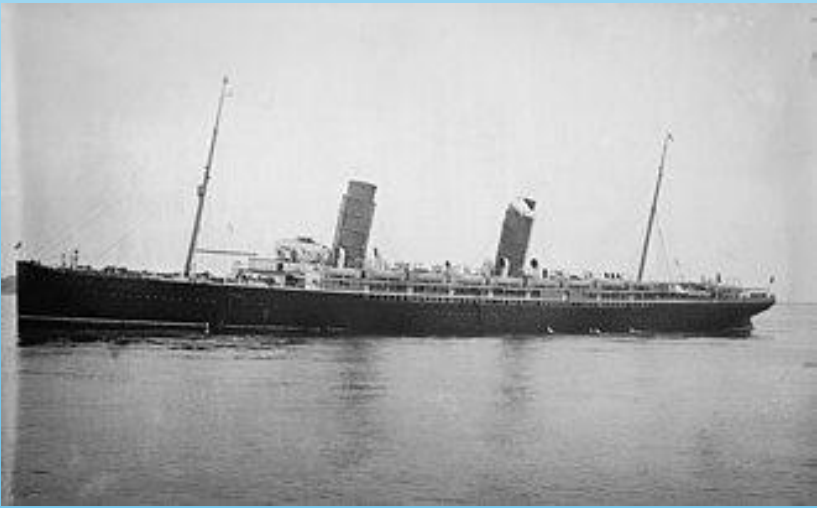

In 1892, the Gummerus begin their journey to North America.

On April 23, 1893 Emanuel, Amanda, and their children Lauri, Werner, and Naemi arrived at Halifax, Nova Scotia, aboard *the Mongolia* before continuing to Michigan's Copper Country.

In 1896, Amanda and the children departed New York aboard the *Lucania* for Liverpool, England. They presumably travelled home to Finland. The reason is not known.



On August 24, 1897, Amanda and the children returned from Glasgow, Scotland, aboard the *Circassia*.

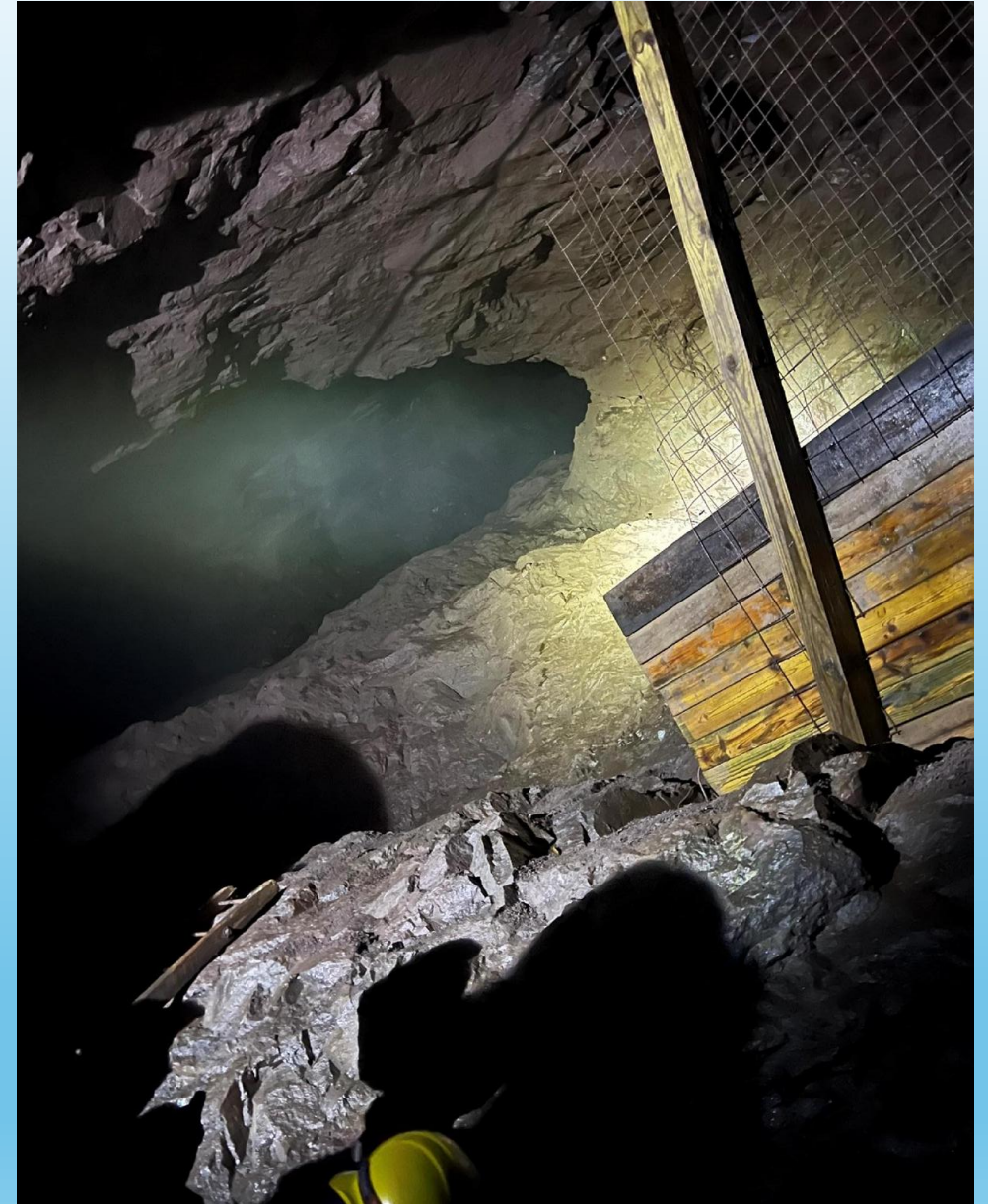


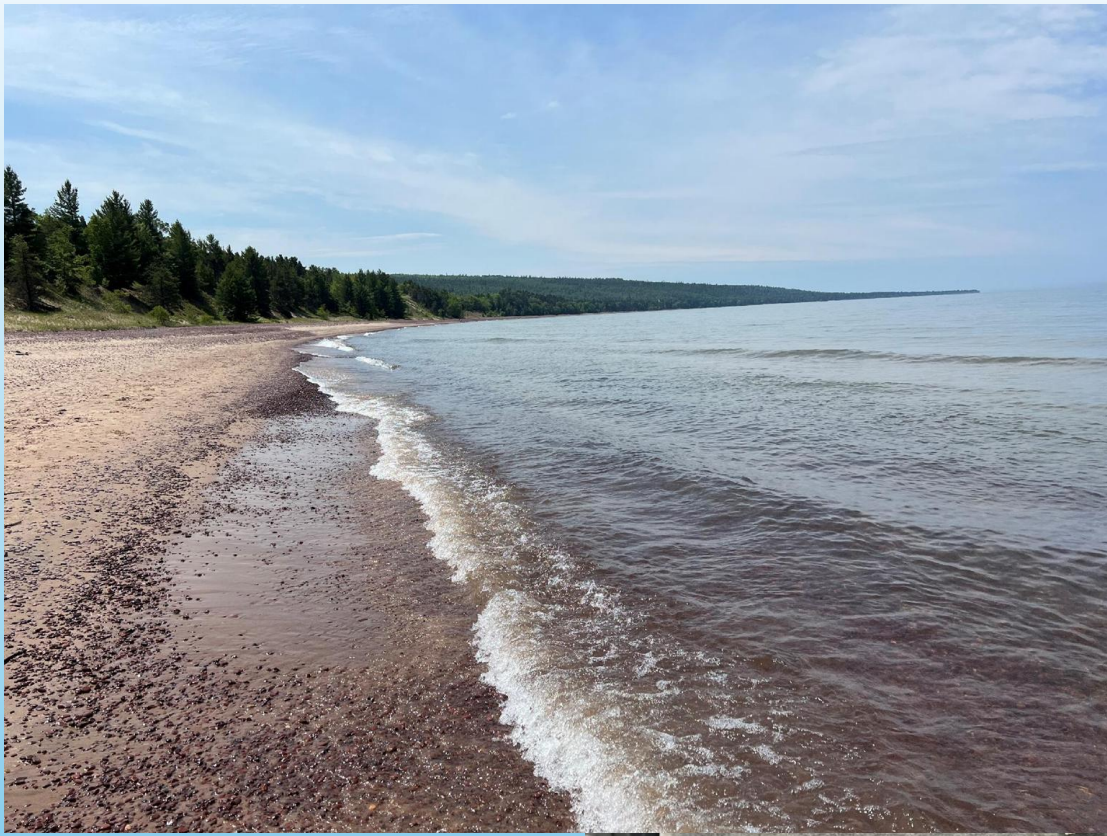


The Quincy Mine in Hancock, Michigan.

- In 1899, while employed by the Calumet & Hecla Mining Company, Emanuel suffered a catastrophic mining accident. His employee record states that he was "blasted, both eyes, right arm and left hand lost." Despite these life-altering injuries, he survived and remained employed by Calumet & Hecla.

- In 1900, Emanuel worked as a copper miner, and Amanda managed the household.
